

MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST 16, 2010 SELECT BOARD MEETING

Board members present were Gene Armstrong, Dan Champney, Ron Lafreniere, David Parot and RJ Vallie. Also present was Town Clerk Deborah La Rivière. The meeting was called to order at 5:45 pm.

Gene motioned: "To accept the minutes from August 02, 2010." Ron seconded. There were no changes or corrections, all were in favor, motion passed.

The Board reviewed the letter from the Green Mountain Club but tabled further action until more information could be obtained.

Highway logs were reviewed.

The VLCT will be scheduled sometime in September to review the town's general liability policy.

Treasurer's Reports for July were read.

The shoulder work on the Notch Road, as of this meeting, has not been corrected. The Board instructed Deb to pay for the paving, but not the shoulder work.

Lexi Haselton and Ray Atwood from the Conservation Commission met with the Board. The group is working on writing a Management Plan for the Preston Pond property and would like to form a sub-committee, which could include a county forester as well as townspeople and Select Board members. RJ motioned: "To encourage the Conservation Commission to form a representative group to work on a management plan for the Preston Property." Gene seconded. A survey in the town report might be useful. There was no further discussion. All were in favor and the motion passed. CRAG-VT wants to amend their existing easement to connect the Upper west section with the Preston Property. This will help with continuity on the properties. Some concerns voiced by the Select Board were parking and cost of re-doing the easement. The CC will forward CRAG's existing easement to the Select Board for review.

No other business needed to be brought before this Board at this time. Gene motioned to end the meeting, seconded by Ron. The meeting ended at 6:45pm.
